2s Class (Finches), Age 2 by Sept. 1

4s Class (Robins), Age 4 by Sept. 1

Mon. & Fri.: 9-11:30 a.m.; Wed.: 9 a.m.-1 p.m.

Kindergarten (Kinderbirds), Age 5 by Sept.1

Tues., Wed., Thurs.: 9 a.m.-2 p.m.

* A "Music and Movement" class is taught by a music teacher and is offered to the 3s, 4s and Kindergartners. Weekly Spanish enrichment is included in the Kindergarten curriculum.


